

Stafford Hamlet Town Hall Meeting

June 9, 2007

The Stafford Hamlet Town Hall meeting was called to order by Carol Yamada, Board Chair at 10:05AM.

Opening Remarks: Carol thanked everyone for coming. She introduced Board members present: John Kuhl, Bill Markt, John English, Molly Ellis, Mike Stewart, Dave Adams. She reminded people present to pick up their informational Hamlet survey on their way out as they leave at the end of the presentations.

Carol introduced Doug McClain, Director of Planning for Clackamas County. Doug discussed his role and that of the county in regard to planning for the Hamlet. He gave updates on the Stafford Tualatin River Bridge redo and the Borland/Stafford Round-About. The Stafford Bridge construction will begin next spring. The time for the Round-About is tentatively set for next summer, but some prep work may begin next spring as well. He encouraged our Planning group to stay in touch with the County to mesh our planning with the County planning for the Hamlet area.

Carol then introduced the Hamlet committee chairs (Scott Richmond, Planning; Sally Quimby, Outreach; Molly Ellis, Goal 5 & Open Spaces; Bill Markt, Finance. Each gave a report for their committee.

Scott reported that the planning was on schedule with the timeline. This can be reviewed on the Hamlet website at www.staffordhamlet.org. Anyone who wishes to be involved with this group should talk with Scott at the end of the meeting.

Sally reviewed the papers on each table and encouraged those present to read and take the opportunity to participate in the three working committees.

Molly explained how the Goal 5 map was being developed and asked that anyone with riparian areas contact her at the end of the meeting to outline their property.

Bill reviewed the work of the Finance Committee to raise funds to finance the work of the Hamlet. This includes postage for the surveys and other mailings, monies that will be needed to support the planning project, other expenses to provide outreach to our Hamlet community.

Carol introduced Elizabeth Normand and Gail McEwan from the Oregon Consensus Project. Elizabeth and Gail reviewed how they could work with the planning group and the Hamlet in the process of development of a conceptual plan.

Meeting was adjourned at 12N.
